

Welcome to Stavanger!

Transfer to the pier where your **Private Yacht** is waiting for you.

During this cruise we visit some of the most famous locations of the Lysefjord, like the Pulpit Rock, Kjerag Boulder and Flørli – but also some lesser-known gems that will leave you breathless. We also take you further along the coast up towards Bergen and beyond, where we will visit secluded fishing villages, an old trading station renovated into a charming hotel, and nice restaurants.

In <u>Hardanger Fjord</u> you will see one of the biggest glaciers in Norway, and much much more. This is the ultimate way to experience Norway.

The first day we take you to the spectacular Lysefjord, where you will see the famous Pulpit Rock, taste fresh water from the waterfalls, and experience several other stunning locations. Among the sights we visit is Kjerag, the crown of the Lysefjord, a 1000 meters vertical wall, famous for its base jumpers and stunning views.

We also take you to <u>Flørli – the worlds</u> <u>longest wooden staircase</u> for a walk around the area. After lunch onboard, we cruise further to a beautiful lagune at Helleren and drop the anchor or stay at a private pier to spend the first night.

Optional activities for this day:

Hike Preikestolen, Hike Kjerag Boulder, Bicycle rental, Walk around at Flørlii 4444, Helicopter Tours. More info on the activities page at the end.



Idyllic island communities

After we have indulged in spectacular views in the Lysefjord, we will continue the cruise into the coastal communities in Ryfylke among idyllic islands with history from the Viking era and before.

The names of the places we take you to next are <u>Stjernarøy</u> and a small family hotel at <u>Ramsvig</u>. Ramsvig is located on the beautiful "<u>Church Island/Kyrkøy</u>". It's an old trading place where fishermen met farmers in the old days. One of the old buildings has been restored by a local family, and they are now running a nice little romantic and charming seaside hotel.

We also take you to **Jøssingfjord**, a charming fjord that offers breathtaking natural beauty, and is rich in historical significance.








Optional activities for this day:

Explore Kyrkøy by foot or bicycle. Tender boat excursion between all the beautiful Island around Stjernarøy. Fishing.



The place hidden from the rest of the wold.....

If the weather allows, the next destination is Røvær, a unique fishing village where we will cruise through small islands with narrow gaps to find the protected community in perfect shelter of the winds and waves of the North Sea. The local restaurant/hotel is known for splendid seafood along with beautiful sunsets on the utter west coast of Norway. We also spend the night here, where you wake up to the sound of seagulls and calm waters.

Enjoy a coffee in the back of the yacht while you see local fishermen in action. You can explore the island on foot with a local guide. See the old houses, beaches, lagunes, historical Viking grounds – This little island has everything. Do you want to go fishing? We can organize this with a local fisherman.





Optional activities for this day:

Walk around Kyrkøy by foot or bicycle. Tender boat excursion between all the beautiful Island around Stjernarøy.



Hardangerfjord and Rosendal

Rosendal in Hardangerfjord, our next destination, is surrounded by tall snow-cowered mountains and incredible scenery. Rosendal is the gatway to Hardangerfjord, and where you can even visit one of the biggest glaciers in Norway, "Folgefonn" We can even organize helicopter tours to see it from the sky. Or do you want to go skiing on the glacier? We can arrange that as well.

There is also a historical rose garden, **Baroniet**, more than 300 years old – from the medieval times. We can organize transport from the boat harbour, where you get to spend time walking around the grounds with more than 5.000 different roses. We then take you back to the yacht or to the Rosendal Fjord Hotel for a delightful dinner.





Optional activities for this day:

Visit Bondehus Lake. Helicopter tours. Summer-ski at Folgefonna glacier. See the famous Rose garden at Baroniet. Hotel & Spa at Ullensvang Hotel.



Hello Bergen!

Cruising our way to <u>Bergen</u>, your final destination of this cruise. If time allows, we can make a stop at <u>Brekkjarvik</u>. The building here has rich history going back centuries, with lovely gardens and interior that will take you back to a different era.

Brekkjarvik Gjestgiveri is a high-end restaurant. Awarded for it's delicious food and it's famous chef (world champion from the Bocuse d'or Lyon in 2015).

Yor final destinations is **Bergen**, a modern city, rich in culture and history. We hope you enjoy the trip, and wish you happy travels further exploring Bergen and beyond.

Activities & excursions from Lysefjord



Hike to Preikestolen / Pulpit Rock

Hiking with a professional tour guide incl. transport with a car from Forsand in Lysefjord and back to the yacht.

Estimated time 6 hrs



Bike rental

You can choose between electrical bikes or traditional bikes if you want some more exercise. Explore by yourself, or with a guide.

Estimated time 3hrs or more



<u>Hike to Kjerag Boulder</u>

Hiking with a professional tour guide incl. transport with a car from Lysebotn in Lysefjord and back to the yacht.

Estimated time 7-8 hrs



Helicopter tour

A 30 minutes flight to see the amazing Lysefjord from a birds eye view. Take-of and return at Flørli Powerstation.

Estimated time 45 minutes

Activities & excursions from Hardangerfjord & Rosendal



Hike to Bondehusvannet

Hiking to the Bondehusvannet (the lake under the Folgefonna glacier) with one of the crew or by yourself. Transport included.

Estimated time 3-4 hrs



Fonna Glacier Ski Resort Center

Fonna is one of Europe's leading summer ski centres, located 1,200 metres above sea level on the Folgefonna glacier in the hart of Hardanger

Estimated time 4-7 hrs or more



<u>Helicopter tour</u>

A 30 minutes flight to see the amazing Hardangerfjord and the glacier Folgefonna from a birds eye view.

Estimated time 45 minutes
